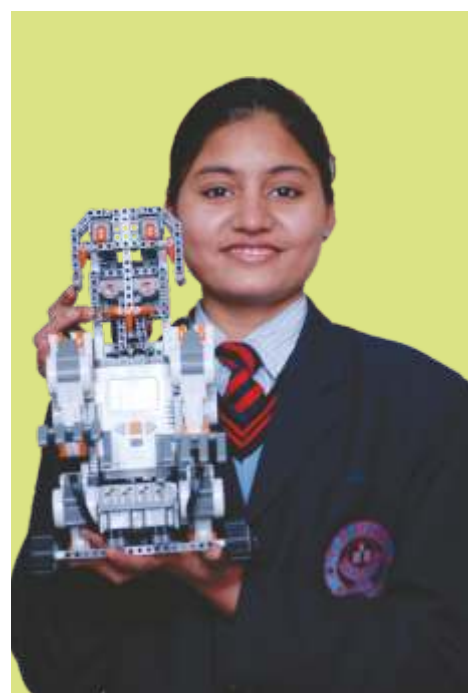

The National Talent Search Examination (NTSE) is a national level scholarship program in India to identify and nurture talented students. At YS Schools, we leave no stone unturned in grooming our students' skills, in making them understand deeper concepts and in imbuing them with such a confidence that they could easily clear such prestigious competitive examinations. This year our student, Khushal Bansal of Y.S. School Barnala, has made a



history by clearing All India NTSE Exam. In 2010, he is the only student from this area to get NTSE Scholarship and NTSE scholarship holders are given scholarship in Education throughout life to whatever institution they study.

Robotics

We, first Schools in area, are getting students ready for the 21st century through Robotics. Believing in the philosophy that the purpose of School is not only to prepare students for the

present but also to groom them for what is laying at a distance. We are proud to share that our students from Y.S. School Barnala went to Delhi to compete in All India Robotics FLL Championship, where they displayed exceptional ability at the assembling, presenting and explaining the Robots and Won the competition by winning over the teams of Chandigarh and Delhi. Our school also sent eight teams of 7th to 9th class students at All India Robotics Olympiad held at Noida. Y.S. School was the only School from the Punjab State participating in the competition and these competitions indeed provide immense exposure and competitive edge to the students.
